#### **Historical Note:**

The very first schoolhouse was built in what is today West Tisbury in 1652. This schoolhouse was used for Christian education for the Wampanoag tribe. The first public schoolhouses in the village of Tisbury can be dated as early as 1737. The town built the public schools and arranged school districts in 1792 as a requirement of a Massachusetts law of 1747 that required public schools to be available to students of the town. There were two school houses in the north and south end of the village. In 1854, one schoolhouse was built on Center Street. This building was torn down sometime during the 1930s and the students moved to the new school building. The new school was built in 1929 on West William Street and an addition was added in 1938. This school is still being used today.

## **Scope and Content Note:**

The Tisbury School 1850-1999 Collection has been artificially created. There is no original order to these documents. Librarians, interns and volunteers have worked to assemble this collection at some point. The MVM was created in 1922 and started collecting documents in 1923. The final assembly of this collection was done in June 2011. This collection of 4.5 cubic feet, contains official bills and receipts from Tisbury Schools, including teachers' salary receipts generally from 1850 to the 1897. There are also several official school records and reports about Tisbury school year and tuition and student records. The collection also contains student material and school memorabilia including students' work, yearbooks, programs for school events and graduation memorabilia. There is also Susan Johnson's research paper, "Exploring Art Education History: Identity of place in a New England island community."
